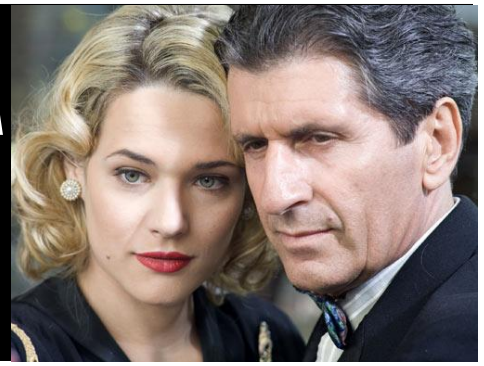


ITALIAN FILM FESTIVAL USA

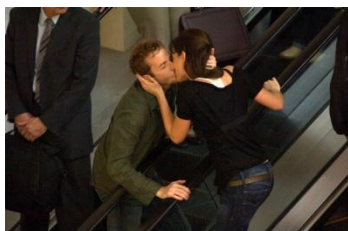


BAARÌA
