A restless fifteen-year-old, who grew-up without a father and is in search of guidance, and a childless professor, who left teaching to escape to a boring routine of tutoring private students, find themselves forced to live together. While the professor has difficulty understanding how to get along with a teenager intolerant of rules and studying, they eventually come to understand each other.

After Gennaro dies, he lives on in Peppino's imagination, as if his cousin was the superhero that he said he was.
